Life Eco-pulplast

Local circolar economy by an innovative approach for recycling paper industry pulper waste into new plastic pallets.



The <u>LIFE ECO-PULPLAST</u> project aims at demonstrating the possibility to recycle pulper waste – the industrial waste of paper mills that use recovered paper – in the manufacturing of eco-sustainable plastic pallets.

ECO-PULPLAST PROJECT NEWS

Project activities continue according to plan. **Most importantly, the prototype line was** recently ordered and is currently under construction.

The prototype line consists of an automatic machine to produce euro-pallets by injection moulding of thermoplastics materials, and includes a number of innovative solutions to process mixed plastics waste in presence of impurities, such as those composing paper mills' pulper waste. The line is composed of an injection unit, a vertical press, a mould-holder, an upper extraction system and a PLC control unit.

Experimental activities and tests will be conducted on the prototype line and will allow to demonstrate at industrial scale the identified recycling technology in terms of pulper waste process workability, development of new plastic compounds and production of euro-pallets from waste mixed plastics.

On May 22, the Second Edition of the "<u>Italian companies towards Zero Waste</u>" Prize took place in Capannori, Tuscany. This special recognition, given by the Zero Waste Research Centre and Zero Waste Italy, means to reward companies which have

distinguished themselves for the implementation of best practices for reducing, recycling and reusing waste in the different production phases. In this year edition, the awarded twelve companies range their activities from manufacturing to agriculture, from the ICT to the food industry. The event, organized by Zero Waste Italy, the Zero Waste Research Center of Capannori and Ambiente e Futuro association, was also supported by the Municipality of Capannori.
